

Instructions for Activity – Use the table you completed in Part 1 of Activity 3 to help you complete the following activity.

1. Insert the Focal KSAs you listed in the table in Activity 3 into the **Focal KSAs column** in the **Item Ideas Table** on the following page.
2. Review the ***Observational Investigation design pattern*** resource sheet and select the Potential Observations that you believe will best provide you with evidence of each Focal KSA, as well as the Potential Work Products that will act as instances of the evidence and put them in the appropriate columns in this table.
3. Based on the Focal KSAs, Potential Observations and Potential Work Products you selected, write down some item ideas (i.e. how you will elicit evidence) in the last column of the table for each of these categories.
4. Discuss with your group how Additional KSAs could be used to identify sources of measurement error, and how Variable features could be used to shift the difficulty or emphasis, in your item ideas (and storyboard scenes).
